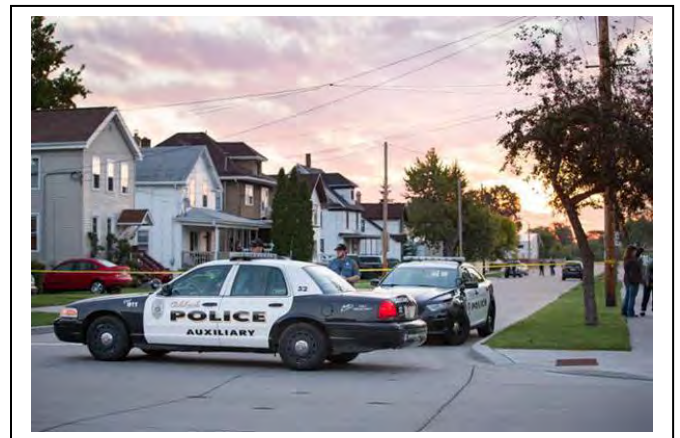
CRT Call-Out....Thank You!:

Thank you to Sharon and Joe Youngbauer for the treat after our meeting.

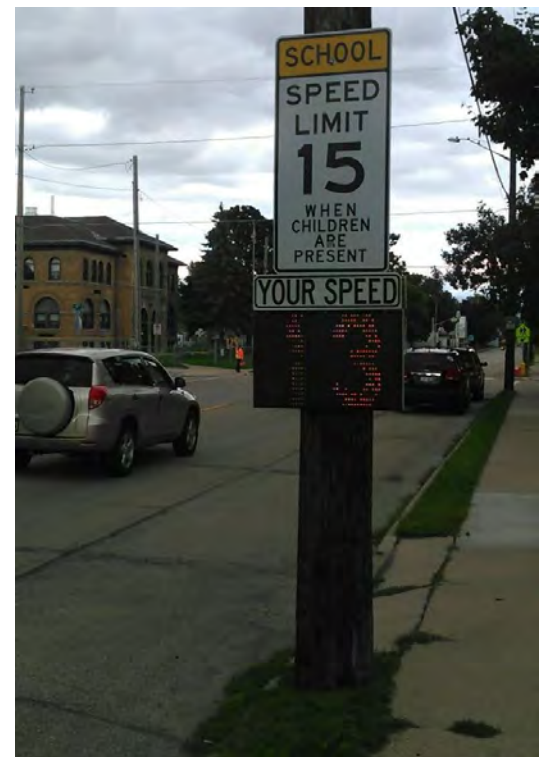
