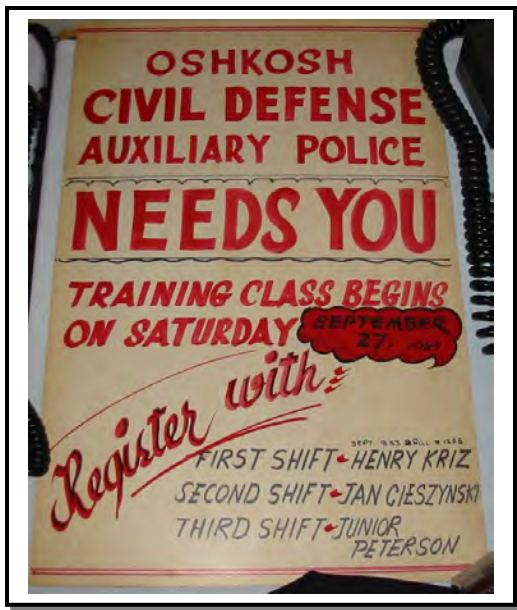


**Dustin Easton**

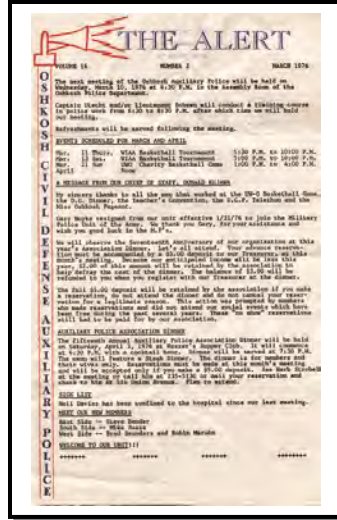

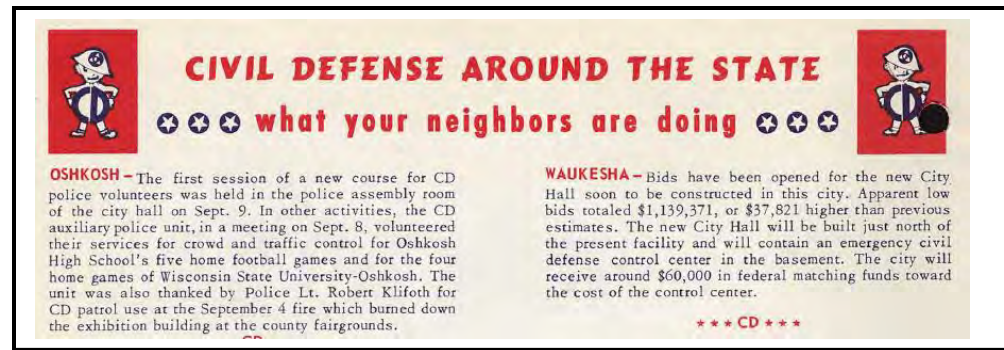
1969 Recruiting Poster – North American Rockwell “The Axle” Oshkosh Plant

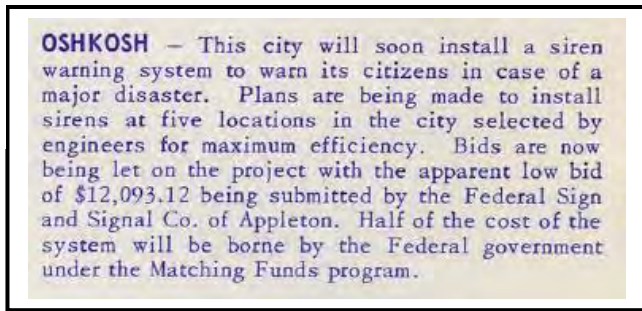

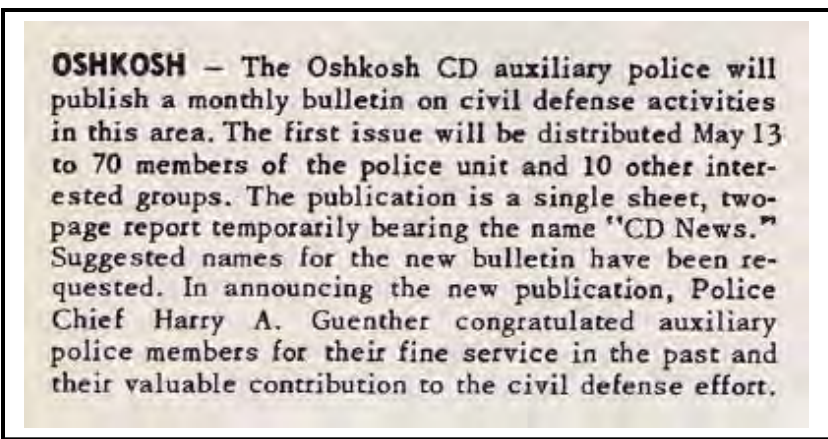

**Discussion on service awards** were discussed, and other options that were suggested by Mike Suess. We decided that we would choose four service awards and have criteria to achieve those awards. We need to have more meetings for this group. This project should be ready by January 1st.

**Event staffing computer program** was used during the SWAT training exercise. Sgt. Harris said it worked well, but it has some glitches to be worked out. This should also be ready to go by January 1st.
