Subject: Disturbance near the University of Wisconsin - Oshkosh

The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating a disturbance which occurred on Cherry Street near Lincoln Avenue. On Saturday, February 10, 2018 at 1:33 AM Officers from the Oshkosh Police Department and University of Wisconsin – Oshkosh Police Department were dispatched for a report of two men who were “jumped” in this area.

The investigation revealed two men were walking when a large group of approximately 15 individuals approached them. A physical altercation occurred between the two men and the group. Both men sustained injuries from the altercation. The injured individuals did not require a medical transport for their injuries.

The University of Oshkosh – Oshkosh Police Department sent out a Titan Alert to the UW – Oshkosh students regarding this incident due to the proximity to the university.

At this time no arrests have been made regarding this incident. The Oshkosh Police Department is continuing to work to identify the individuals involved. If anyone has information about this incident please contact the Oshkosh Police Department at (920) 236-5700.
