Subject: **UPDATE:** Accident at W. 9<sup>th</sup> Ave/ Sawyer St

**\*\*\*\*UPDATE\*\*\*\***

**The Oshkosh Police Department's Accident Investigation Team has finished their evidence collection at the intersection of the accident (W 9<sup>th</sup> Ave/ Sawyer St) and the road is now open for vehicles.**

On June 28, 2018 at 12:48pm officers were dispatched to a traffic accident involving a motorcycle and an SUV. The initial investigation revealed that a motorcycle driven by a 46 year old Oshkosh man was eastbound on W. 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue when it was struck by a SUV. The SUV was driven by a 52 year old Oshkosh woman who was turning westbound onto W. 9<sup>th</sup> Av. At this time the operator of the motorcycle has sustained serious injuries and was transported by ambulance to a local hospital. The female was uninjured and is cooperating with the investigation.

At this time the Oshkosh Police Accident Investigation Team is on scene and the intersection of W. 9<sup>th</sup> Av. and S. Sawyer St. is closed down. We ask that vehicles avoid the scene until further notice.
