Subject: **UPDATE:** Body in a Vehicle Located in Lake Winnebago near
Bowen Street Fishing Dock

UPDATE: The deceased male that was located in the vehicle has been identified as a 23 year old male from Manitowoc. The vehicle he was located in is a Red Volkswagen Golf. On 05-20-19 the Manitowoc Police Department initiated a welfare check on this male. If anyone had contact with this individual between 05/19 to 5/20 please contact Detective Krueger at (920) 236-5733.

OSHKOSH, WI (May 21, 2019): The Oshkosh Police Department is currently investigating an incident in which a body was located in a vehicle in Lake Winnebago, approximately 150 yards from the Bowen Street Fishing Dock in the City of Oshkosh.

On 05/20/2019 at approximately 6:00 AM, the Oshkosh Police Department was notified that there was damage to the railing at the end of Bowen Street Fishing Dock. The damage indicated that a vehicle may have caused the damage to the railing and may have entered into Lake Winnebago.

The Oshkosh Fire Department responded to that location and their dive team began a search of the lake but they were unable to locate the vehicle. The Winnebago County Sheriff's Department's Dive team responded to the location and began a search utilizing sonar. The vehicle was located and inside of the vehicle was a deceased person.

An autopsy is being performed today by the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office and the investigation is still on going.
