Subject: Bicyclist vs Train Accident

(Oshkosh, WI): October 27, 2020: The Oshkosh Police Department is currently investigating an accident involving a bicyclist and a train at the intersection of Washington Avenue and the Train Tracks in the City of Oshkosh.

On 10/27/2020 at approximately 4:19 PM, officers were dispatched to a 911 call for the report of a male bicyclist who was traveling eastbound on Washington Avenue and was struck by a Northbound train.

Upon arrival at that location, officers located a 69 year old male from Oshkosh who had been struck by the train and had suffered serious injuries.

The male was treated and transported by the Oshkosh Fire Department Ambulance Service to a local hospital where he later succumbed to his injuries. The train was held on scene for the investigation and several intersections south of New York Avenue were closed for approximately 2 hours. All intersections are open at this time, and traffic can proceed normally.

This incident is still under investigation. The name of the victim is not being released at this time pending family notification.
