Subject:	UPDATE: Substantial Battery Incident at Wisconsin
	Resource Center

UPDATE: The 56-year-old victim died last night at 9:10 PM at a local hospital. His death was caused by the injuries he sustained during the battery which occurred on 05/21/2024. Neither one of the individuals involved was an employee of the facility. The 41-year-old suspect is being referred to the District Attorney's Office for First Degree Intentional Homicide.

On 5/21/2024 at approximately 2:52 PM, officers responded to 1505 North Dr (Wisconsin Resource Center) in the City of Oshkosh to investigate a report of a substantial battery incident between two persons. This is an isolated incident between two individuals, which occurred in the courtyard area at their facility. No other persons were injured and there is no risk to the public.

The 56 year old male victim was transported to ThedaCare Regional Medical Center in Neenah for his injuries, and is currently being treated at their facility.

The other person involved with this situation is 41 year old male. Neither one of the individuals involved was an employee of their facility. The Oshkosh Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division is currently investigating this incident.
