UPDATE: The Oshkosh Police Department has been working in conjunction with the City Attorney's Office regarding 1402 Walnut Street in the City of Oshkosh. The Winnebago County Circuit Court has issued an order to close this residence due to continued drug related problems at this location and being deemed by the court as a public nuisance. The court order states that the property and premises located at 1402 Walnut Street is closed with no individuals being allowed to access, visit, occupy or reside there. The City of Oshkosh/Oshkosh Police Department has authority to enter the property at any time to enforce and ensure compliance with the court order.

OSHKOSH, WI (June 06, 2024): The Oshkosh Police Department completed a drug investigation at a residence located in the 1400 Block of Walnut Street in the City of Oshkosh.

Based upon drug information that Investigators from OPD's Vice and Narcotics Unit received, a search warrant was issued for a residence in the 1400 Block of Walnut Street. On 06/05/2024, OPD's Vice and Narcotics Unit along with Detectives and Lake Winnebago Area MEG, conducted the search warrant at this residence. As a result of this search warrant, seven individuals from Oshkosh were arrested.

These individuals range in age from 35-74 years old. The 35-year-old was arrested for Carrying a Concealed Weapon, Felony Bail Jumping and a Probation Hold. The 39-year-old was arrested for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Felony Bail Jumping and a Probation Hold. The 40-year-old was arrested for an outstanding warrant, Possession of Methamphetamine and Misdemeanor Bail Jumping. The 45-year-old and the 49-year-old were arrested for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Felony Bail Jumping. The 61-year-old was arrested for Maintaining a Drug Dwelling. The 74-year-

old was arrested for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Possession of Illegally Obtained Prescription.
