OSHKOSH, WI (June 23, 2024): The Oshkosh Police Department is currently investigating an accident involving a pedestrian and a train at the intersection of E Parkway Avenue and the train tracks in the City of Oshkosh.

Earlier this evening, at approximately 6:53 PM, Officers were dispatched to a 911 call for a report of a male pedestrian on E Parkway Avenue who was struck by a Northbound train.

Upon arrival at that location, officers located a 23-year-old male from Oshkosh who had been struck by the train and was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The Oshkosh Police Department's Accident Investigation Team and OPD Detectives responded to the scene and are continuing to investigate this accident. The train is currently being held on scene for the investigation. Due to this, the railroad tracks south of E Parkway to E 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed during this time.
