Subject: UPDATE: Weapons incident

UPDATE: In reference to the incident in the 1000 block of Jefferson Street in Oshkosh. On 3/17/2025 Oshkosh Police Detectives continued their investigation into this incident and took a 16-year-old female from Menasha into custody for First Degree Attempted Homicide, three counts of First Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety, and one count of Cruelty to Animals. The 16-year-old female was placed at a secure detention facility.

The Oshkosh Police Department wishes to thank the Menasha Police Department and the Calumet County Sheriff's Office for their assistance in this investigation.

The safety of our citizens is our top priority. The Oshkosh Police Department stands against gun violence that effects our community. These are senseless acts that threaten the safety and peace of our neighborhoods.

OSHKOSH, WI (March 14, 2025): The Oshkosh Police Department responded to a weapons incident that occurred in the area of the 1000 block of Jefferson Street in the City of Oshkosh.

On 3/14/2025 at approximately 9:30 PM, officers from the Oshkosh Police Department were dispatched to a weapons call in the 1000 block of Jefferson Street. There was a report of numerous gun shots in the area. Officers immediately responded to the area and learned that a specific residence was struck by multiple bullets and that there were no reported injuries. The subject responsible for the shooting is known to the victims and fled in a vehicle prior to officers' arrival.

The identity of the shooter is known; however, due to the age of the suspect, their name is not being released and they are still at large at this time. The

Oshkosh Police Department has attempted to locate this person at numerous addresses throughout Winnebago and Outagamie counties but have been unsuccessful.
